SPAIN: Identification model for citizens of Spain within the eP/eD project

1. Patient identification document

The identification of spanish citizens is carried out by presenting their Health Insurance Card and one document with photo (passport or national identity document)

2. Identifiers

There are two types of identifiers:

a. Citizen identifiers


i. National Person Identifier.- it consists of 8 “B”, followed by 2 letters and 6 numbers. This identifier could be recognized by the pattern BBBB BBBB*****.

ii. Regional Person identifier.- it has variable format and extension combining numbers and letters.

b. Region identifier: this numeric identifier could be recognized by this pattern 8034** (six digits). Spain has several regions and each of them has a different health card model. This identifier **ONLY** needs to be included when in the health card is included the Regional Person Identifier but not included the National Person Identifier.

In the case that the health card does not show the region identifier the pharmacist must know the number to be introduced, how it is shown below.

In the following figure, it is described the two options to identify citizens of Spain:



3. Spanish Health Insurance Card models

Depending on the model of health insurance card, some codes or others must be typed. This information is detailed below.

- a. **Model 1.-** only one number must be typed: **National Person identifier** (BBBBBBBB*****)).


b. Model 2.- two numbers must be typed: **Regional Person Identifier** and **Region Identifier (8034**)**



- c. **Model 3.-** two numbers must be typed: **Regional Person Identifier** in the front and **Region Identifier** (8034**) in the back



- d. **Model 4.-** in these models only the Regional Person Identifier or personal identifier are included in the cards without the Region Identifier, but it is necessary to introduce it. Below we show the Region Identifier to be typed by the pharmacist. This situation only happens on five types of health card, described below.






